### **Minutes**

#### 1. Minutes

To receive the Minutes of the AGM held on Sunday 18 November 2018

- The minutes of last year's (2018) minutes were proposed by Mike Bentley and approved by Edward Ben-Nathan.
- The President role on a rotational basis was suggested (in an informal show of hands at the meeting 8-12 voted against).

#### 2. President's reports

- Mike Bentley confirmed his decision to step down as Club President after 10 years of service.
  Martyn Webb thanked him on behalf of the Committee and club members.
- Squash refurbishment (new carpets, front wall plastering, new heaters, squash court floors polished, lights changed to LED)
- Tennis courts were refurbished, the trees were trimmed around the courts to prevent the court surfaces from being covered with leaves which made them unsuitable/dangerous to play on. New toilets were built, and the tennis hut was refurbished (new carpets, furniture, kitchen furniture)
- Barnet Council approved the application for a new flood-lit tennis court last year and it is in place for three years before it expires.

#### 3. Treasurer's reports

- The accounts were proposed by David Brodie and approved by Madeleine Abramson.
- The 2019 accounts report was provided at the meeting and Treasurer, Martyn Webb, talked the audience through it.
- Larger expenditures: £250,000 was spent on building and refurbishment, new Cricket square (£26,000 grant secured for the works by Sport England) and the downstairs changing rooms (crack on the floor and wall, toilets)

#### 4. Secretary's reports

- Laura Rakos confirmed her decision to step down as Club Secretary. Her replacement will be Lara Greenfield.
- Secretary's reports were covered in the President and Treasurer's sections. There was nothing further to add.

#### 5. Neighbour liaison's reports

- The trimming of trees and their positioning for construction works are issues. These are being discussed at Committee level.

#### 6. Reports from Cricket, Squash and tennis

- Tennis: The Ladies' First team is doing well in the Middlesex League. Summer Camps are well attended and successful (360 children playing/day). Three Juniors were selected by Middlesex. The Coaching team is in a great shape. The new toilets project cost £109,000. Slightly higher than the estimated amount. Future projects: new court planning permission approved (needs a project lead/plan), fencing. Tennis sinking fund: £47,000 as of 01/12/19

#### 6.1 Bar update

- The bar is staffed as an when needed by members of the club. Bar staff wages were increased to £10/hour.
- 2 Wolfpack beer taps were installed and were popular among members and away team members during league matches.
